While we cultivate students' artistic talent, we also work to create pathways for students to consider futures in arts education. This grant funded program currently serves the communities of Yakutat, Craig, Klawock, Ketchikan, and Juneau. As a regional program, we believe Sitka Fine Arts Camp is a perfect arena for students to enrich their artistic perspectives.

There are many talented students in Southeast Alaska who may not otherwise be able to attend Sitka Fine Arts Camp without financial assistance. Voices on the Land is eager to make available five scholarships for tuition, housing, and travel, to Alaska Native students.
