Welcome to YPDT!

YPDT is committed to providing an environment where young people's voices are heard; where they are given agency and can develop the empathy and responsibility needed to become future leaders of strong communities. We train young people to be observant listeners, insightful creators, thoughtful critics, passionate thinkers, and committed leaders through the medium of technical theater arts.

WHAT DOES YPDT LOOK LIKE?

YPDT is a kid-focused design training program, exploring what it takes to put on a professional production. In class, we will dive deep into one of the 4 major design categories: Lighting, Sound, Props, and Scenery. Your student will create and implement designs as an assistant, with guidance from a lead designer.

YPDT works in conjunction with Young Performers Theater (YPT) and Young Performers Technical Theater (YPTT) to assist in the design and implementation of technical elements for each production.

Class Schedule:

Because the nature of the class is individual and depends on the needs of each production, the class schedule is created based on how much time the student and teacher has to work, as well as what each production calls for. This will be coordinated before classes start. Ideally, each student will meet with a teacher 2-4 hours a week. Additional class times may be required leading up to tech week.

PREREQUISITE:

All students taking this class must be invited after completing YPTT with substantial

comprehension and interest.

Class Description:

In this class, we will spend a majority of the semester preparing to assist YPT's productions. Students will learn the advanced functions of one major design department for a performance - lighting, costuming, sound, scenery, props. We will dive into design and practicality within the professional theater world. Throughout the semester, students will learn safety within a theater, confident communication, and how to be a creative and adaptive designer.

Registration:

YPDT students will register through the SFAC website for the regular YPT tech program but will have different meeting times and responsibilities as discussed with the instructor.

Students should arrive no more than 5 minutes before class starts and leave no later than 5 minutes after class ends. Please communicate with me if you anticipate being late or absent.

Location: Classes will move between Odess Theater on the SFAC campus and YAW 101 on the SFAC campus.
